Upcoming Festivals

ZIRO MUSIC FESTIVAL

Ziro Music Festival –The Ziro Music Festival- celebrated on 27th Sep till 02nd Oct, founded in 2012 by Bobby Hano and AnupKutty, is a remarkable music festival held in the picturesque Ziro Valley of Arunachal Pradesh, India.



DURGA PUJA

Durga Puja, a major festival in West Bengal, Assam, Tripura, Odisha, and Bihar, celebrates Goddess Durga's victory over Mahishasura. The festival lasts for 10 days, with the final five days being the most significant.

MAHALAYA

TAWANG FESTIVAL

Permit Regulations

STATE	INDIAN NATIONAL	FOREIGN NATIONAL
SIKKIM	No Permit for entry, Permit only for Restricted areas (Changu Lake, Lachen, Lachung)	Inner Line Permit for entry (Can be issued at the border check post – no charges) Citizens from China, Pakistan, Myanmar, Taiwan and Nigeria need to get the permits from Ministry of External Affairs or Indian High Commissions in their respective countries.
ARUNACHAL PRADESH	Inner Line Permit required (Require Valid Indian ID proof to issue the same)	Protected Area Permit required. Documents needed are filled Permit form, Passport, valid Indian VISA and International flight tickets (both arrival/departure)
NAGALAND	Inner Line Permit required (Issued on the spot, valid Indian ID proof required)	Copies of Passport and Visa need to be submitted at entry point at the state border or at Dimapur airport.
MANIPUR	N/A	Copies of Passport and Visa need to be submitted at entry point at the state border or at Imphal airport.
MIZORAM	Inner Line Permit required (Require Valid Indian ID proof to issue the same)	Copies of Passport and Visa need to be submitted at entry point at the state border or at Aizwal airport.

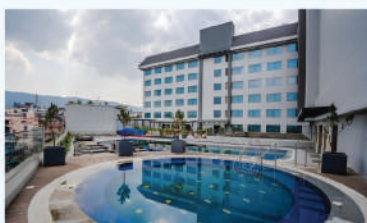

SUNDARBANS

The forest also houses other fascinating fauna, including various bird species, chital, crocodiles, and snakes. The flora of Sunderbans is equally captivating, with abundant sundari, gewa, goran, and keora trees dominating the landscape. The region's characteristic tree, the sundari (*Heritiera littoralis*), is where the forest derives its name and yields a durable hardwood used for building houses, boats, furniture, and other items.

Best Time to Visit: The best time to visit Sunderbans is from September to March, as the winters provide the most pleasant weather for exploring this unique ecosystem. Summers can be hot and humid, but travel is still possible during this period.

Mode of Transportation:

1. Drive from Kolkata to Gothkhali
2. Boat Journey into Sunderbans
3. Exploring the Sunderbans by Boat: The interconnected waterways make it possible to explore almost every corner of the forest by boat. Your expert guides will navigate through the labyrinthine channels, revealing hidden gems and breathtaking vistas. Keep your cameras ready as you may spot the elusive Bengal tiger, various bird species, chital, crocodiles, and other wildlife during the journey.

Plucking tea by hand is a traditional way of harvesting tea from the tea tree and enjoy the tea tasting. Return to Darjeeling by evening.
